

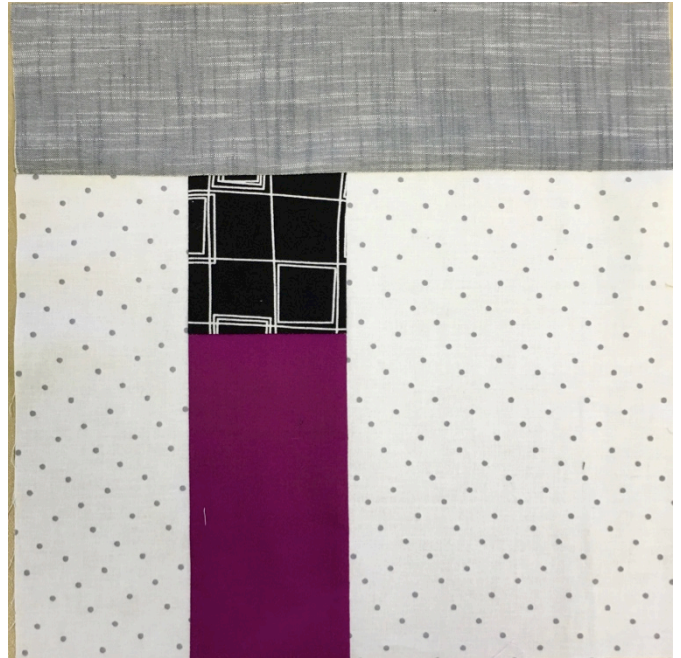
## Block of The Month 2016: Block #6

Block is due at the September meeting.

This month we are continuing our black, white, grey, and one color of your choice palette. We encourage you to make two blocks, one to enter in the drawing and one to keep. This block is pretty simple, but be accurate on your seams and sew a scant quarter inch. The block is called It's All About Me, Myself, and I by Christopher Thompson.

### Cutting Instructions (for one block):

- Cut one 3.5" x 3.5" Black square
- Cut one 3.5" x 6.5" Color strip
- Cut one 3.5" x 9.5" White strip
- Cut one 6.5" x 9.5" White rectangle
- Cut one 3.5" x 12.5" Grey strip



### General Instructions:

Following the block photo, using a 1/4" seam allowance and right sides together, sew the Color strip to the Black square to create the "i" piece. Press.

- Sew the White strip to the left of the "i" piece.
- Sew the White rectangle to the right side of the "i" piece.
- Sew the Grey strip to the top of the "i" block.
- Trim the block to 12.5" x 12.5".

Hope you enjoy making this block and even though it is a simple block, it can make a wonderful quilt if you play with the orientation of the block.
