## Block of The Month 2023: Block \#4

Here is our next log cabin variation -- called a Half Log Cabin block. The 2023 focus fabric is from Hoffman and is called Paint Impressions. In addition to the focus fabric, you will need a white fabric and two additional coordinating fabrics based on the colors in the focus fabric. Remember, all our blocks end up $12.5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{X}$ 12.5" (a 12 " finished block.) We will have the focus fabric available for sale at guild meetings for $\$ 3$ per fat quarter.
Also, the Guild's website and Facebook page should have a post directing you to the YouTube instructions for this block.

## Cut list -- For one block:

Focus Fabric: $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ square; 2.5" X 4.5" rectangle
White: $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 32.5^{\prime \prime}$ strip (sub-cut into these lengths: $2.5^{\prime \prime}$, 4.5", 6.5", 8.5", 10.5"

Coordinating fabric $1: 2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime} ; 5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$
Coordinating fabric 2: 2.5" X 10.5"; 2.5" X 12.5"
This is a very simple block - easy to put together. The beauty of this block becomes apparent when you make a lot of them. This block when arranged creatively can give a quilt a 3D appearance.

## Assembling the block: Use a scant quarter inch seam. Press to the newly added fabric

- Step one: join white 2.5 " square with focus fabric $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ square. Press. Add focus fabric 2.5" " X 4.5" rectangle to an adjacent side and press. (Photo 2.)
- Repeat these steps with correct size pieces in the following order: white, coordinating fabric 1 , white, coordinating fabric 2 . Always add new fabric to the fabric added in the prior round. If your pieces don't fit - check your seam allowance and that you have the correct fabric for the round.
- Now to square it up. Use your $121 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ " square up ruler, place it over the block. Trim to $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.
