Fabric requirements: The sample is used for color guide. I Please change to what you would like

1 Fet Quarter - fabric A - (yellow) background or ± yard. Swag row. Bring all the left-over fabrics to class

1 Fat Quarter - fabric B - (green contrast) or scrap 5 \(\frac{1}{2} \times 21" \) or \(\frac{1}{2} \) yard. Curvy row.

1 Fat Quarter - fabric C - (sunflower print to busy print, 5 \(\frac{1}{2} \times 21'' \) or \(\frac{1}{2} \) yard. Curvy row.

1 Fat Quarter - fabric D - (green) background or ‡ yard. Chained triangles row.

1 Fat Quarter - fabric E - (black dot) binding, dots, bias strip, and chained triangles.

1 Fat Quarter - fabric F - Blas strip on curvy row

Assorted Scrops - 18 @ 2 \ x 6" (4 or 5 different prints, 4-5 of each) Braid

Assorted Scraps - 6 @ 3 \ x 7 \ (4 - 6 different prints that will coordinate in groups of two) Swags

2 Fat Quarters for the pillow back

22" square of batting and a scrap of fabric for quilting the pillow top. (Muslin or similar) Not necessary to bring.

Supplies:

1 zipper 15 or longer"

Freezer paper (the role or at least a yard).

Basting glue (such as "Raxanne's Baste It") Elmer's School Glue also works.

Invisible thread in smoke and clear. Such as Superior-Mono Poly, Wonder Invisible Thread, or YLI. <u>Bobbin</u> thread if you have it. Marking pens: FriXon, fine tip marker, pencil, and chalk style pencil.

Mat and rotary cutter are necessary. Cutting ruler 6" x 24".

Sewing machine with all the usual supplies. Bring your manual for using the zipper foot. Regular thread also.

→ OPEN TOE FOOT™ is very helpfull This accessory is usually purchased separately. You'll be glad you bought it.

Please before class cut the following: X X X X X

| Fabric A (yellow background). 1 - 6" x 20 \fractangle

Fabric B (green contrast, curvy row) . . 1 - 6" x 21" rectangle

Fabric C (sunflower print, curvy row). . 1 - 6" x 21" rectangle

Fabric D (green background)....... 4 - 5\frac{1}{2} squares and 2 - 1" x 21" strips

Fabric E (black) and A (yellow) 2 - 51" squares each color.
